2009-2010 School Calendar

The first semester begins August 13th and ends Dec.18th. The second semester begins Jan.4th and ends June 4th. Each day begins at 8:30am ending at 3:35pm. Elementary students have 5hrs 30mins of instruction each day and secondary students have 6hrs 20mins of instruction each day. Students spend 174 days in school.

Extra-curricular Activities

Shenyang International School has an active secondary school student government. SYIS offers students music, fine arts, athletics and Chinese culture; offering secondary students girls' and boys' basketball and volleyball, as well as boys soccer. Secondary students can also participate in choir, student council and a China studies tour each fall.

Graduation Requirements

- 1 credit of Bible per semester enrolled in the high school
- 4 credits of English
- 3 credits of social studies
- 3 credits of science
- 3 credits of mathematics
- 2 credits of foreign language
- 1 credit of physical education/health
- 1 credit of fine arts
- Electives as selected

24 units of high school credit are required for graduation. One half credit is given for each full semester of a course successfully completed in grades 9-12, with electives receiving one quarter credit for each full semester of a course successfully completed.

International Accreditation

Shenyang International School was accredited in 2006 by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) for a full accreditation term.

WASC is a US accreditation association, based in California.
